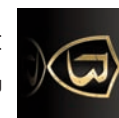

EHS TRAINING PROGRAM



EHS productive techniques and training drills are employed every second you are on the ice. EHS has an innovative and high-tech program that keeps student moving through group instruction and individualized drills, leaving no room for "down time". Creativity and hard work are encouraged to help each student reach their full potential. At the conclusion of the week each student will receive a written report card with skills test scores along with a detailed description of their strengths and weaknesses. EHS emphasizes the mechanics of the stride and shot.

The staff are experienced, enthusiastic instructors who have been selected for their hockey backgrounds and their ability to effectively teach young players. Each coach has demonstrated an ability to make the learning experience both interesting and educational.

CAMPS VALUES

Noel Rubin and his staff guarantee you will improve as a hockey player. Whether you are a house league player or travel team player, we can take you to the next level. **"Hard work and perseverance make the difference"**

Skating is the most important aspect in the game of hockey. Our goal is to improve each player's skating skills through a step by step program. Hockey is unlike all other sports, where you already know how to run. To learn hockey, you must first learn how to skate, you can then learn the game of hockey, including stick handling, passing and shooting. **"If you cannot skate, you cannot be a successful hockey player"**

The game of hockey is played in your head as well as on the ice. Learn the skill of knowing where to be on the ice when you don't have the puck and what to do with the puck when you have it. **"Patience is a key component that separates the good players from the great players"**

CLINICS AND CAMPS

TOTAL CAMPS

Total camps are designed to improve the skills of novice, intermediate and travel players, with focus on the basics of stick handling, skating, passing and team play.

ELITE CAMP

A 3:1 student/instructor ratio is used to maximize the potential of the high-level hockey player. The ice time enhances all hockey skills while off-ice time teaches conditioning, strategy and shooting. All participants will be chosen based upon coaches recommendations and an evaluation by the staff. Skylands camp will be 15 hrs of ice time, the Mennen camp will be 16 hours of ice time.

PRE-SEASON TUNE UP

Conditioning and Skills - This camp will prepare players for the upcoming season. Aerobic drills and strength training are covered, along with a review of basic skills.

SUMMER SUNDAYS

EHS Summer Sunday Clinics are open to all mite and squirt level skaters. The primary goal of this weekly hour long clinic is to improve each player's individual skating skills. Clinics are on Sunday evenings at Mennen Arena in Morristown, New Jersey. Sessions will have a strong focus on power skating, edge balance, agility, quickness, and speed. Techniques for puck control and scoring will also be covered.

CHOWDER CUP

Junior Chowder Cup Players born in 1995 July 8th -11th in conjunction with the Toronto prospect tourney May 21st - 23rd.

Senior Chowder Cup Players born in 1992-1993 July 21st-25th, jersey entrance fee and practices all included. Elite Division 17-20 yrs. old.

MENNEN SUNDAY NIGHT SCRIMMAGES

Sunday night scrimmages are to help keep the players on the ice over the summer with top end competition and to keep skills refined and tuned up for the upcoming season. Sessions are 90 minutes and are a quick warmup and followed by a full ice scrimmage.

3V3 LEAGUE MITES /SQUIRTS

The 3v3 league is designed to keep players touching the puck more often in a small area. Teams will have 6-7 players and there will be 3 games per session with 17 minute running time. It is a 6 week league.
